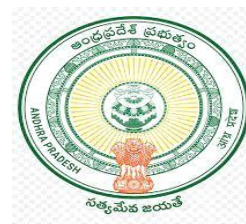

We celebrated Babu Jegjeevan Ram jayanthi and Jyothi Rao phule Jayanthi combindly on 11/04/2023 as it was public holiday on 5th of April. Babu jegjeevan Ram was a notable Indian freedom fighter, and politician who fought for the rights of the oppressed classes such as scheduled castes. He was a member of parliament fo 30 years consecutively. He holds the record for being the longest-serving cabinet minister in India as Union Ministaer of Labour 1946-1952.

Jyothi Rao phule was an Indian social activist, anti-caste social reformer and writer from Maharashtra. His work extended to many fields including eradication of untouch bility and the caste system and for his efforts in educating women and oppressed people. All the staff members participated in the programme.

Ultimately, it is up to each individual to make the decision not to take drugs.



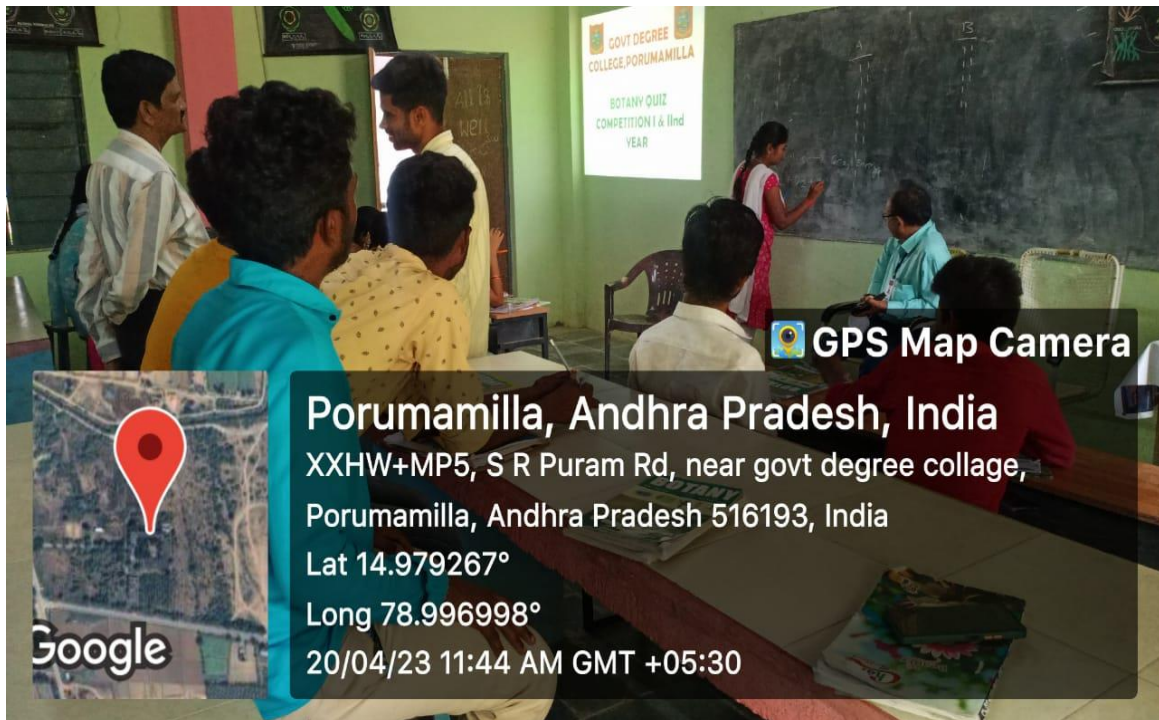
3. AMBEDKAR JAYANTHI 14/04/2023

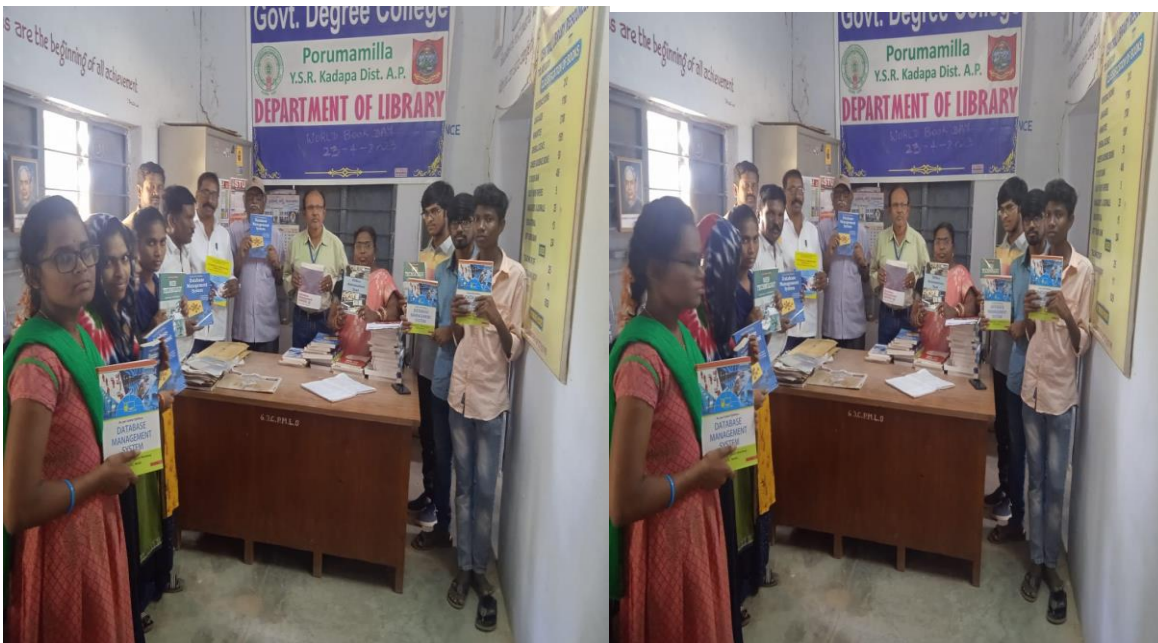
5. THE WORLD ENGLISH LANGUAGE DAY & BOOK DAY

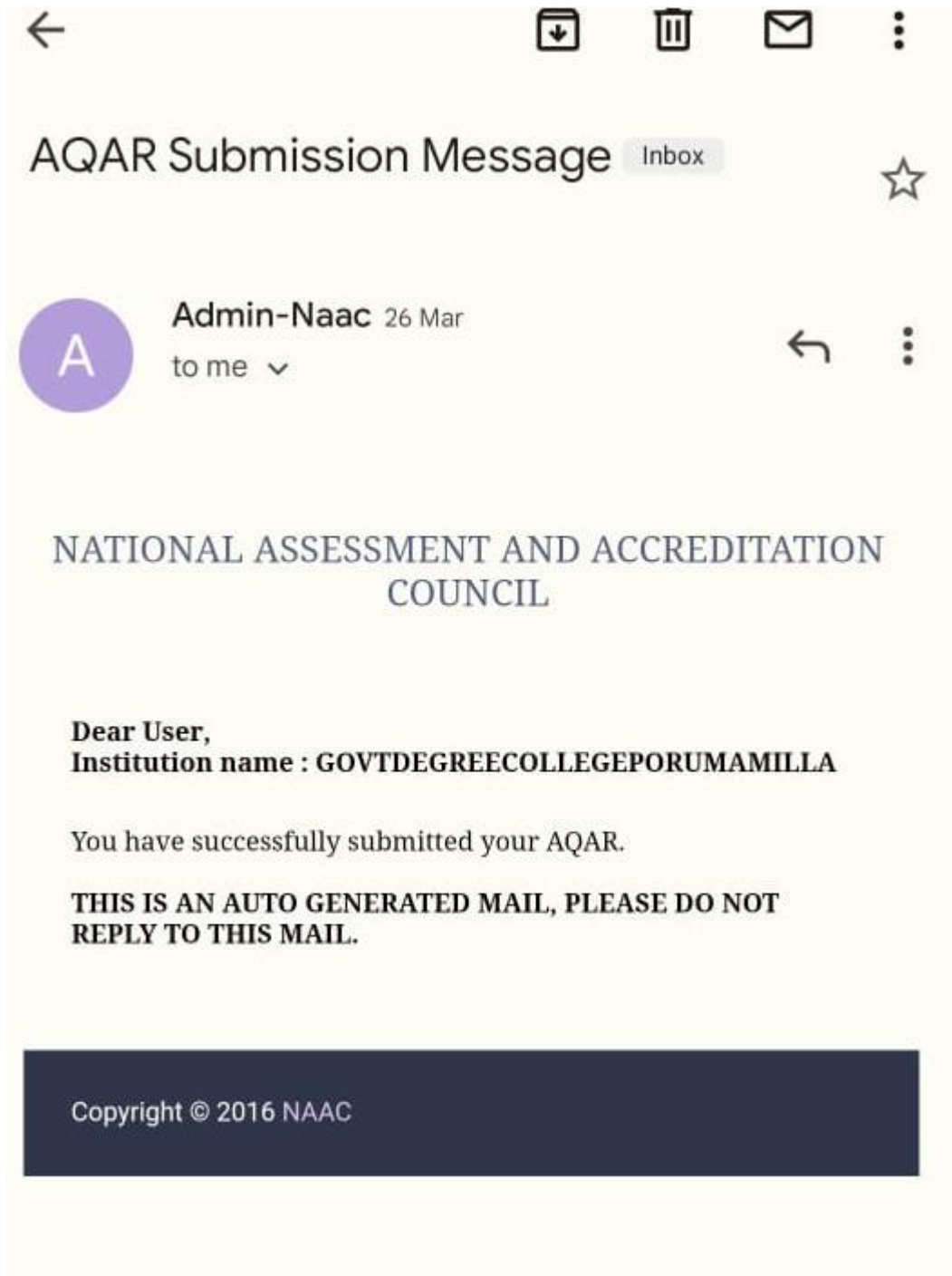
09. INVITED LECTURE BY DEPT.OF CHEMISTRY

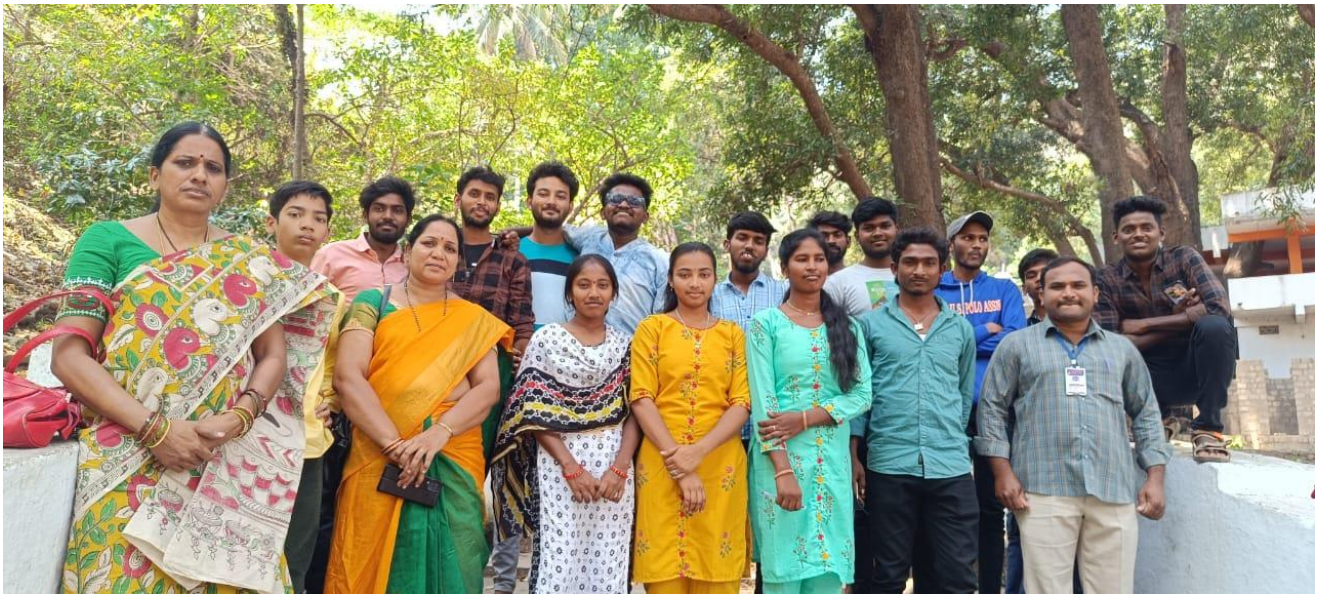


FIELD TRIP TO BHIRAVAKONA BY B.A., STUDENTS
