The Practice:

Blood is a human life and a precious resource. Blood cannot be manufactured by artificial means. To save somebody's life somebody has to donate the blood. There are cases when people need the blood immediate and are unable to find the exact blood group. Through the blood donation camps students are motivated to donate the blood voluntarily without expecting anything in return. The students are made aware that anyone can donate the blood and it is only the blood that shows us that we all are one. Blood saves someone's life, no matter what the blood recipient's religion or caste is. The intention of organizing the blood donation camp is to convey the message to the society as many people are not aware of the blood donation as a social responsibility. Through the donation camp students blood groups and Hemoglobin percentage is checked. The blood bank also issues the cards and the certificate to the donors. Blood donors are often given priority in case of emergency or accident.
